Barry came to us under an arrangement with Cricket Ireland following the successful match between the two organisations in February 2015 at Coogee Oval as a World Cup warm-up. A right arm fast bowler he had impressed good judges with his pace in 2nd Grade where he had played five matches and taken 12 wickets. He made his 1st Grade debut in round 8 against Penrith at Howell Oval taking 1-35 off nine overs in a limited overs match. He was also at the wicket when the last man Jake Wilson was run-off the penultimate ball for the side to go down by two runs, 225 to 9-227cc. Barry remained seven not out off six balls.

In 8 matches in 2nd Grade he took 12 wickets at 26.41 with 3-32 his best. He hit 189 runs with a top score of 51.

On his return to Ireland he was selected to represent Cricket Ireland in a number of international matches, the first being against Sri Lanka at Dublin in June 2016 where he took 2-69 off 9 overs.
